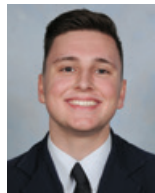

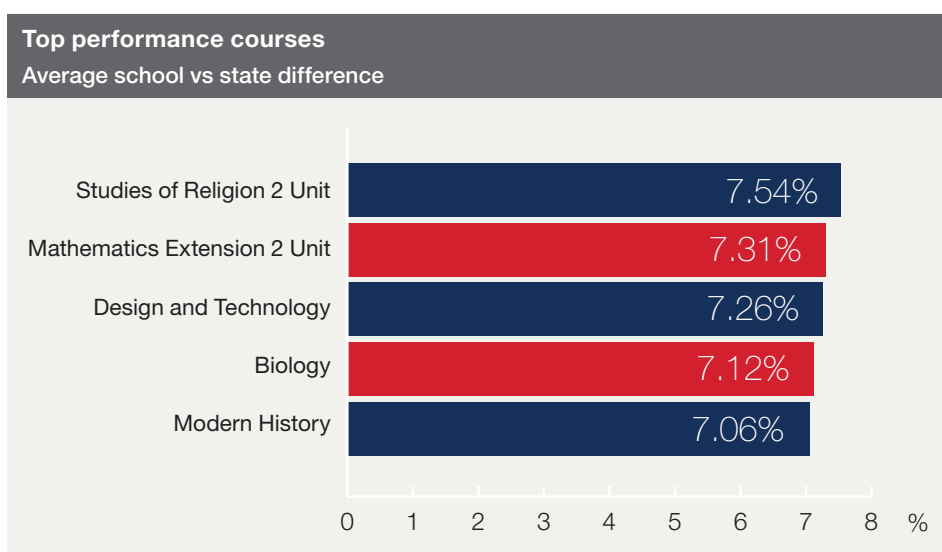

## HSC courses above the state average

Trinity Catholic College students have again performed solidly in the Higher School Certificate. In the 2017 HSC, Trinity students recorded **81** Band 6's or distinguished achievers (scores of 90 or greater).

**17** students scored an ATAR above **90**.

174 students in Year 12 sat the HSC with approximately 1002 exam papers in 29 different courses. Trinity students recorded **81** Band 6s or distinguished achievers (scores above 90).
