HSC courses above the state average

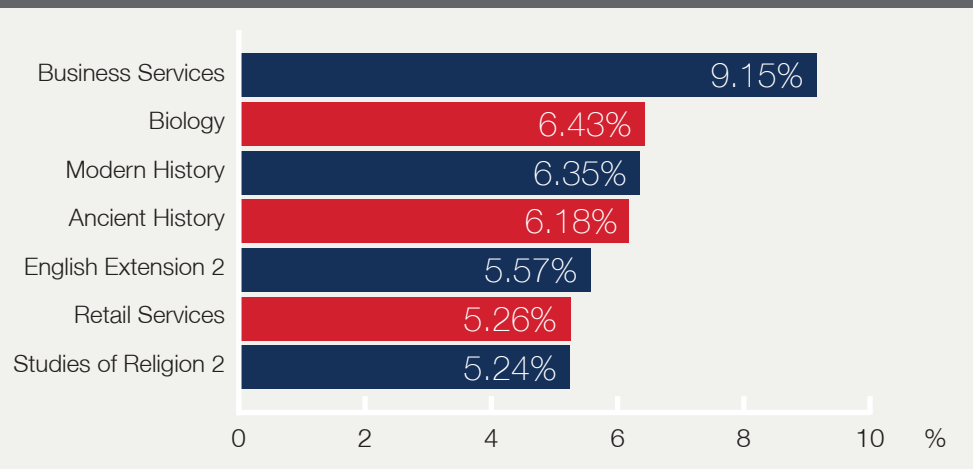
32 courses studied at Trinity Catholic College **29 courses were above the state average.**

182 students in Year 12 sat the HSC with approximately 950 exam papers in 32 different courses of which **91% of these courses were above the state average.**

The highest HSC mark in a course was **96**, by **Bruce Tang** in **Mathematics Extension 1** and **Natalie Thai** **48** in **Extension 1 English.**
