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## TERM 3 COVID RESTRICTIONS

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### Learning

- All learning being delivered remotely
- Single mode of delivery
- HSC subjects which need specialty equipment, group performance or specialist in person instruction can come to school in small groups (strict COVID safe guidelines)



### Students

- On site only for essential supervision
- Classes only for HSC students (specialty or practical classes that cannot be held remotely)
- Students with significant wellbeing or learning needs should contact Principal for support



### Staff

- Education = authorised workers for purposes of movement
- Skeleton staff only on school sites to supervise
- Staff who live in Fairfield/Liverpool/Canterbury Bankstown LGAs but work outside them should work from home wherever possible
- Staff who live in Fairfield LGA but work outside must be tested every three days (72 hours) if they are attending school
- Any staffing issues contact System Performance Team
- Any leave questions contact People and Culture



### Wellbeing

- All wellbeing services continue (including counselling online)
- Family check-in calls weekly



### Safety

- Masks mandatory for all staff (indoors and outdoors)
- Masks mandatory for secondary students indoors (Year 7+) and on transport (13+ years)
- All adults maintain physical distancing at all times (1.5m)
- QR code check in must be used by all staff and visitors



### Facilities

- All construction paused
  - Cleaning to continue
  - Any urgent maintenance for safety allowed
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
