Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your patience as we waited for official advice about the return to school.

NSW Health and Government have been clear from the outset that in leaving decisions until the end of the holidays they would have the benefit of the latest health advice. To keep up to date we ask all families to monitor the advice from NSW Health by [clicking here](#).

Yesterday the Premier of NSW announced that the current lockdown in place for Greater Sydney would be extended for a further week.

This has necessitated a return to school via online learning from Tuesday 13th July, following the Parent/Teacher interviews on Monday for Year 7 to 10.

The Schedule for Week 1 Term 3

At this stage remote learning will continue until Friday 16th July and the Government is suggesting we will return to face to face learning from Monday 19th July. **Online learning will commence at 8:30am on Tuesday** and will follow the regular week one timetable. The only change will be an **extended recess** break on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday instead of Pastoral Care. During this time, we encourage students to get some fresh air and move away from screens and technology.



Procedure for Online Learning:

Students are to attend their scheduled timetabled classes via Google classroom where teachers will mark the roll and students will then complete work under the direction of their teacher. If students are unable to attend class, parents are to call/email the school office to explain the students absence as per our usual procedures. Students who fail to log into their classes and complete a satisfactory level of work will be requested to attend school.

IT Support:

If your child is having any IT issues, they are to be raised with our IT department ASAP so that this can be resolved by phoning the College Office on 9749 1919 or sending an email to ict.14477@sydstu.catholic.edu.au. This email will only be monitored during online learning.

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For those **parents who are essential workers** and cannot arrange care for their children next week, supervision will be provided at school where the remote learning can be completed.

QR Code and Masks

If there is a reason that you need to attend the school, you will be required to check in and out using the QR code on display at the front of the school. Adults and students will need to be wearing masks and maintain physical distance whilst indoors.
